C-1830 In the Matter of US West Communications, Inc., Denver, Colorado, seeking authority to file its notice of intention to file Section 271(c) application with the FCC and request for the Commission to verify US West's compliance with Section 271(c): Gene Hand informed the Commission that the Final OSS Report was received May 29, 2002. An order granting in part and denying in part Qwest's motion for rehearing of the QPAP was entered. The final Oral Argument previously scheduled for June 3, 2002, at 1:00 p.m. was rescheduled to 9:00 a.m. on June 3, 2002, in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln.

C-2516/ PI-49 In the Matter of the Commission, on its own motion, seeking to investigate Qwest Corporation's rates for interconnection, unbundled network elements, transport and termination and resale services: Gene Hand provided the Commission with copies of staff memorandums. The staff prepared two memos: one related to the compliance filing made by Qwest and the other addressed Qwest's Exhibit "A" to the Amended SGAT. Gene Hand discussed the idea of setting a workshop to establish a procedure for future SGAT rate changes. The staff was directed to schedule a workshop.

C-2666 In the Matter of Qwest Corporation, Denver, Colorado, seeking approval of its revised statement of generally available terms (SGAT) pursuant to Section 252(f) of the 1996 Telecommunications Act: A discussion was held regarding future Qwest filing of amended SGATs. The staff was directed to schedule a workshop to establish a procedure for amending SGATs.

Gene Hand provided the Commission with copies of ALLTEL's Service Quality Report for April 2002.
