By order entered May 17, 1982, Iowa-Nebraska Tele-Marketing Co., Omaha, Nebraska, was authorized by the Commission to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device.

Investigation has revealed that the permit holder has failed to file a copy of its application and permit with the telephone company as required by the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

Respondent should be ordered to appear at a hearing to be held August 31, 1982 at 2:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 301 Centennial Mall South, Lincoln, Nebraska to show good cause, if any there be, why its authority to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission Rules and Regulations.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Iowa-Nebraska Tele-Marketing Co. appear at a hearing on August 31, 1982 at 2:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 301 Centennial Mall South, Lincoln, Nebraska to show good cause, if any there be, why respondent's permit to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device should not be revoked.
