OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION

By order entered May 17, 1982, Iowa-Nebraska Tele-Marketing Co, Omaha, Nebraska was granted a permit to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device.

By letter dated December 12, 1983, the permit holder indicated that he sold the model CGS 1000 Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device and requested the permit for this model be revoked.

The Commission therefore finds that the permit issued should be revoked.
