OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered May 25, 1982, Roger Challstrom, DBA Diversified Int., Lincoln, Nebraska was granted a permit to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device.

By letter dated January 31, 1983, the permit holder indicated that he sold the model CGS 1000 Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device and requested the permit for this model be revoked.

The Commission therefore finds that the permit issued should be revoked and that Permit No. AD-11 shall only apply to the Model CGS-4K-CPT which the applicant still possesses.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Permit No. AD-10 be and it is hereby revoked.
