OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant proposes to connect an Applied Computer, Inc., ATD-6802 automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant has agreed to include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device a statement of the nature of the call and the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization being represented.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the application does comply with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission.
