OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed October 8, 1982, GET, Inc., Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device.

Applicant is a corporation whose mailing address is 1518 Regency, Lincoln, Nebraska 68506.

Applicant proposes to connect a Telematic Model ASD Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device with FCC registration number AK 296 G 62392 MAN.

The Commission staff has determined that the FCC registration number provided in the application does not allow the device to be connected to the telephone network for automatic dialing solicitation.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device proposed to be used by GET Inc., is not properly registered with the FCC therefore it cannot be connected to the telephone network for automatic dialing solicitation and the application should be denied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-24 be and it is hereby denied.
