OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed October 12, 1982, Mick Shannon, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks authority to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device.

Applicant is a partnership whose mailing address is P.O. Box 14312, Omaha, Nebraska 68124.

Applicant proposes to connect a Skutch Electronics Model Dialer II Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device with FCC registration number B07-99H-67824-AN-N.

The Commission staff has determined that the FCC registration number provided in the application does not allow the device to be connected to the telephone network for automatic dialing solicitation.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device proposed to be used by Mick Shannon, is not properly registered with the FCC therefore it cannot be connected to the telephone network for automatic dialing solicitation and the application should be denied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-25 be and it is hereby denied.
