OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed February 21, 1984, Brubaker Mundorf Insurance Inc., Fremont, Nebraska seeks authority to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device.

Applicant is a corporation whose mailing address is 2070 N. Lincoln, Fremont, Nebraska 68025.

Applicant proposes to connect a National Telecommunications Model Ben automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant has agreed to include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device a statement of the nature of the call and the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization being represented.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the application does comply with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-59 be and it is hereby granted and Brubaker Mundorf Insurance Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's Official Permit as hereinbefore set forth.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of this permit and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall file a copy of its application and this permit with the serving telephone company.
