OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION

By application filed October 16, 1984, Chuck Bixenmann, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device.

Applicant is a partnership whose mailing address is 3120 South Street, Lincoln, Nebraska 68502.

Applicant proposes to connect a RIKA Communications, Inc., Model Surveyor 7 automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant has agreed to include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device a statement of the nature of the call and the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization being represented.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the application does comply with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-72 be and it is hereby granted and Chuck Bixenmann be and it is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's Official Permit as hereinbefore set forth.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of this permit and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall file a copy of its application and this permit with the serving telephone company.
