OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed February 20, 1987, Fremont Tire Company, Fremont, Nebraska, seeks authority to connect an Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device.

Applicant is a corporation whose mailing address is East Highway 275, Fremont, Nebraska.

Applicant proposes to connect a Comtel Broadcasting Corp., CBC 7000 automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant has agreed to include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device a statement of the nature of the call and the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization being represented.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the application does comply with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-104 be and it is hereby granted and Fremont Tire Company be and it is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's Official Permit as hereinbefore set forth.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of this permit and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall file a copy of its application and this permit with the serving telephone company.
