OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed November 26, 1990, Merchants Credit Adjusters, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant is a corporation whose mailing address is 7363 Pacific, Suite 214, Omaha, Nebraska. Applicant proposes to connect a Model DTC03-SC automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant has agreed to include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device a statement of the nature of the call and the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization being represented.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the application does comply with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-164 be and it is hereby granted and Merchants Credit Adjusters, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this permit is granted only if the dialer is used in a manner consistent with the Federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act which appears as 15 USCS §1692 et. seq. Any communication over the dialer in connection with debt collection inconsistent with the act will result in the Commission taking the necessary action to revoke the permit.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's official permit as hereinbefore set forth, and shall remain in force and effect for two years from the date of this order unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this permit, and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall file a copy of its application and this permit with the serving telephone company.
