OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 23, 1991, Hotels Unlimited, Inc., of Hallandale, Florida asked for authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in the state of Nebraska.

During the month of June, 1991, the Applicant had several discussions with the staff in regard to compliance with the rule and regulations of the Commission. During those discussions, modifications and concerns were raised about the use of an automatic dialer in connection with 900 services. Although an out of state corporation, applicant expressed desire to comply with all Nebraska laws in regard to the use of automatic dialers.

On July 1, 1991, the applicant sent a letter to this Commission requesting that the application be withdrawn. The applicant has informed this Commission that it plans to connect the automatic dialing-announcing device to telephone lines in the state of Florida.

The Commission finds that it lacks jurisdiction over devices not located in the state of Nebraska.


The application should be dismissed at applicant's request.
