OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed November 19, 1991, Annie Mae Corporation, Tucson, Arizona seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant is a corporation whose mailing address is 8421 E. Cresthill Drive, Tucson, Arizona. Applicant proposes to connect a D41/B automatic dialing-announcing device.

The petition states the applicant will include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device a statement of the nature of the call and the name and telephone number of the business or organization being represented. Applicant requested a waiver of the Commission's requirement that the business's or organization's address be included in the recorded message.

After reviewing the application, the Commission finds the application complies with the applicable statutes and rules and regulations of the Commission. The request for waiver, after review of the proposed messages, does not appear warranted and should be denied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-173 be and it is hereby granted and Annie Mae Corporation, Tucson, Arizona be and it is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska statutes and the rules and regulations of this Commission. The message transmitted shall contain the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization represented.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's official office permit as hereinbefore set forth, and shall remain in force and effect for two years from the date of this order unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this permit, and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall file a copy of its application and this permit with the serving telephone company.
