OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed March 24, 1992, Mort Sullivan, International Marketing Group, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant is a proprietorship whose mailing address is P.O. Box 4578, Omaha, Nebraska, 68104 and whose business address is 5224 North 52nd Street, Omaha, Nebraska. Applicant proposes to connect a Faxtel 2000 automatic dialing-announcing device.

The petition states the applicant will include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device a statement of the nature of the call and the name and telephone number of the business or organization being represented. Applicant requested a waiver of the Commission's requirement that Applicant's address and phone number be included in the recorded message. Applicant also requested waivers of the prohibition against calling emergency numbers as is currently provided by statute as well as of the disconnection requirement. This appears to be an oversight in the way the application was filed.

After reviewing the application, the Commission finds the application complies with the applicable statutes and rules and regulations of the Commission. The request for waivers, after review of the proposed messages, do not appear warranted and should be denied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-187 be and it is hereby granted and Mort Sullivan, International Marketing Group, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska statutes and the rules and regulations of this Commission. The message transmitted shall contain the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization represented.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's official permit as set forth in this order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from the date of

this order unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this permit, and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall file a copy of its application and this permit with the serving telephone company.
