O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

By application filed May 6, 1992, Call Suzie International Ltd., Omaha, Nebraska seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device (ADAD). Applicant's address is P.O. Box 4578, Omaha, Nebraska, 68104. Applicant was granted a temporary permit prior to this order on May 6th, 1992.

Applicant proposes to connect a Faxtel ADAD which was the subject of a grant of authority in Application No. AD-181r (a registration).

Applicant has advised the Commission that the ADAD will be used for advertising purposes and has submitted a written transcript of the message to be transmitted. The petition states the applicant will include on all calls a statement of the nature of the call and the name and telephone number of the business or organization represented. Applicant requested a waiver of the requirement that its address be included in the recorded message.

Upon review, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application complies with the applicable statutes and the rules and regulations of the Commission pertaining to the registration of ADADs. The request for waiver, after review of the proposed messages, is not warranted and should be denied. The application should be granted and the permit in AD-181r revoked.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application AD-188 be, and it is hereby, granted and Call Suzie International Ltd., Omaha, Nebraska be, and it is hereby, authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device as described in its application and in accordance with the applicable statutes and the rules and regulations of the Commission. The message transmitted shall contain the name, address, and telephone number of the applicant.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the applicant's official permit, a copy of which is to

be retained by the applicant; the Commission shall retain the original order in its permanent records. The permit shall remain in force and effect for two years from the date of this order unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the permit granted in Application No. AD-181r be, and it is hereby, revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the ADAD to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device by filing a copy of this order and its application and shall identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in the application within five (5) days of the change.
