O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

By application filed December 8, 1992, The Friendly Computer ("Friendly Computer"), 3327 B Street, Lincoln, Nebraska 68510 seeks authority to connect and operate an ADAD.<sup>1</sup>

Applicant proposes to connect a Watson/1200 VIS Combo, an ADAD which Friendly Computer was authorized to operate pursuant to a registration granted in Application No. AD-193r (Order entered November 24, 1992). The ADAD was originally registered for non-advertising purposes. In its subsequent application, Friendly Computer informed the Commission in its petition that it now seeks to use the machine for advertising. A written transcript of the type of messages transmitted was submitted. The applicant has moved that its application therefore be granted in the form of a permit. Applicant has paid its \$500 permit fee and seeks revocation of its AD-193r registration.

Upon review, the Commission is of the opinion and finds the application complies with the applicable statutes and the rules and regulations of the Commission pertaining to the licensing of ADADs which are used for advertising purposes. The application should be granted. In addition, as part of this application, the registration previously issued in Application No. AD-193r should, for the sake of clarity in the Commission's record keeping, be revoked.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application AD-195 be, and it is hereby, granted and The Friendly Computer, Lincoln, Nebraska be, and it is hereby, authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device as described in its application and in accordance with

the applicable statutes and the rules and regulations of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the permit issued in Application No. AD-193r be, and it is hereby revoked. A copy of this order shall be placed in the AD-193r file and that file shall be closed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the applicant's official registration, a copy of which is to be retained by the applicant; the Commission shall retain the original order in its permanent records.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the ADAD to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the applicant shall notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in the application within five (5) days of the change.
