OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed on November 15, 1994, American Fair Credit Association, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant is a corporation whose mailing address is 3838 N. 63rd, Lincoln, Nebraska, 68507. Applicant proposes to connect a Skutch Electronics, Model CBC 7000 automatic dialing-announcing device.

The petition states the applicant will include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device a statement of the nature of the call and the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization being represented.

Having reviewed the application, the Commission finds that the applicant complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-214 be, and it is hereby, granted and American Fair Credit Association, Lincoln, Nebraska, be and is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission. The message transmitted shall contain the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization represented.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's official permit as set forth in this order, and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this permit, and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall file a copy of its application and this permit with the serving telephone company.
