By application filed on December 21, 1994, Merchants Credit Adjusters, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant is a corporation whose mailing address is 6818 Grover, Suite 200, Omaha, Nebraska 68106. Applicant proposes to connect a Digital Equipment DTC03-SC DECTak1 Text to Speach System automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant has held a prior permit (AD-194).

The petition states the applicant will include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device a statement of the nature of the call and the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization being represented.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-215 be, and it is hereby granted and Merchants Credit Adjusters, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, be and is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission. The message transmitted shall contain the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization represented.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's official permit as set forth in this order, and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in its application within five (5) days.
