O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed on March 31, 1998, Western Union Financial Services, Inc., Paramus, New Jersey, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant proposes to connect an AT&T Conversant II automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant advises this Commission that the device will not be used for advertising purposes and has stated that messages being transmitted will be placed on behalf of clients who have existing business relationships with customers. The applicant understands if its clients desire to transmit messages soliciting customers, a permit must first be obtained. The actual messages transmitted by applicant will vary, but will conform to the requirements of state law.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application does comply with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding the registration of automatic dialing-announcing devices.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-246r be and it is hereby granted and Western Union Financial Services, Inc., Paramus, New Jersey be, and it is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby made the Commission's official registration as hereinbefore set forth and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in its application within five (5) days.
