By application filed on May 31, 2002, Empire Entertainment, LeMars, Iowa, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device. Applicant, Mr. Heath Peterson, is a sole proprietor whose mailing address is 122 Plymouth Street, SW, LeMars, Iowa, 51031.

On July 16, 2002, pursuant to Commission direction, a letter was sent to Mr. Peterson to advise him that the proposed script lacked required information regarding his business address. A second letter was sent to Mr. Peterson on December 4, 2002, to advise him that his application would be dismissed if he did not provide the Commission with a revised script including the business address, by December 31, 2002. As of January 14, 2003, the Commission has not received a revised script.

The Commission, being fully informed, is of the opinion and finds that application AD-288 should be dismissed for lack of prosecution.
