O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On October 14, 2005, Progressive Casualty Insurance Co., (Progressive or Applicant) filed an application with the Commission seeking authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant is an Ohio corporation whose mailing address is 6300 Wilson Mills Road, Mayfield Village, Ohio, 44143. Applicant proposes to connect an Intel P4 Chassis/Dialogic, Model D480JCT/2TL, automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant intends to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device at two locations, accordingly, pursuant to Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Chapter 11, Rule 002.01, the Commission will give Applicant two registration numbers. The above-captioned registration number will permit Applicant to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device at 550 E. 84<sup>th</sup> Ave., Suite E-5, Thornton, Colorado 80229.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable Statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application AD-326r be, and is hereby, granted and Progressive Casualty Insurance Co. of Mayfield Village, Ohio, be and is hereby, authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official registration as set forth in this

order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in its application within five days.
