On October 18, 2005, Northland Group, Inc., (Northland or Applicant) filed an application with the Commission seeking a permit for authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant is a Minnesota corporation whose mailing address is 7831 Glenroy Road, #250, Edina, Minnesota, 55439. Applicant proposes to connect a Natural Micro Systems NMS, Model AG4000 C4T, automatic dialing-announcing device.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable Statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application AD-327r be, and is hereby, granted and Northland Group, Inc., of Edina, Minnesota, be and is hereby, authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official registration as set forth in this order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.
