Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing- announcing devices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application AD-332 be, and it is hereby, granted and Liberty Point Corporation, Tempe, Arizona, be and is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in its application within five days.
