The petition states the Applicant will include on all calls made on the automatic dialing-announcing device, a statement of the nature of the call and the name, address and telephone number of the business or organization being represented.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.


