Applicant contracted with Stones' Phones, 1325 G Street, Northwest, Suite 500, Washington, D.C., 20005, to connect a Compaq Server DL380s/Dialogic D2/480 Nuance TTS software, automatic dialing-announcing device located in Chicago, Illinois and owned by In-Touch Solutions located at 1717 Park Street, Suite 301, Naperville, Illinois, 60563.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-361r be, and it is hereby granted and McClurg for Regent Committee be, and is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.


