By application filed on October 2, 2007, Progressive Casualty Insurance Co., (Applicant), Mayfield Village, Ohio, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device to a telephone line.

Applicant is a corporation, incorporated in the state of Ohio, whose mailing address is 300 N. Commons Blvd., Mayfield Village, Ohio. Applicant proposes to connect an Intel/Dialogic Model D480JCT/2T1 automatic dialing-announcing device located in Thornton, Colorado.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official permit as set forth in this order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.
