By application filed on October 5, 2007, McLeod USA Telecommunications Services, Inc. (Applicant), Hiawatha, Iowa, seeks authority to register the connection of an automatic dialing-announcing device to a telephone line.

Applicant is a corporation, incorporated in the state of Iowa, whose mailing address is One Martha's Way, Hiawatha, Iowa. Applicant proposes to use an Excel switch backed by McLeod USA Enhanced Services Platform to make automated calls to subscribers to notify them of Applicant's planned discontinuance of local exchange service in certain Nebraska markets. The device is located in Salt Lake City, Utah.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-410r be, and it is hereby, granted and McLeod USA Telecommunications Services, Inc., be and is hereby, authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official registration as set forth in this order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.
