By application filed on February 25, 2008, CitiFinancial, Inc., Baltimore, Maryland, seeks authority to register the connection of an automatic dialing-announcing device to a telephone line.

Applicant is a corporation, with its headquarters located in Baltimore, Maryland, whose mailing address is 300 St. Paul Place, Baltimore, Maryland. Applicant proposes to connect an Aspect Model Unison Version 7 automatic dialing-announcing device located in Fort Mill, South Carolina.
