By application filed on October 21, 2008, National Enterprise Systems, Inc. (Applicant), Solon, Ohio, seeks authority to register the connection of an automatic dialing-announcing device to a telephone line.

Applicant proposes to connect an Ontario Systems/NMS/Adtran, model NMS-2035-51047, Adtran 1202.0664 automatic dialing-announcing device located at 6230 Cochran Road, Solon, Ohio.


