O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

By application filed on October 23, 2008, Creditors Interchange Receivable Management, LLC (Applicant), Buffalo, New York, seeks authority to register the connection of an automatic dialing-announcing device to a telephone line.

Applicant is a limited liability company, incorporated in the State of Delaware, whose mailing address is 80 Holtz Drive, Buffalo, New York, 14225. Applicant proposes to connect a Castel, model ESP5168 automatic dialing-announcing device.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-471r be, and it is hereby granted and Creditors Interchange Receivable Management, LLC, Buffalo, New York, be, and is hereby, authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official registration as set forth in this order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in its application within five days.
