By application filed on November 4, 2008, Emediac, Inc., d/b/a Political Calling.com, d/b/a Sonic Broadcast (Applicant), Davis, California, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device to a telephone line.

Applicant is a corporation, incorporated in the State of California, whose mailing address is 712 5<sup>th</sup> St., Ste. E, Davis, CA 95616. Applicant proposes to connect a proprietary automatic dialing-announcing device.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official permit as set forth in this order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.


