By application filed on January 29, 2010, Tele-Town Hall, LLC (Applicant), Arlington, Virginia, seeks authority to register the connection of an automatic dialing-announcing device to a telephone line.

Applicant is a limited liability company, whose mailing address is 4600 N. Fairfax Blvd., Ste. 820, Arlington, Virginia, 22203. Applicant proposes to connect a Dell, model Cisco Catalyst Blade Switch 3130 for the Dell PowerEdge M1000e automatic dialing-announcing device at the Arlington, Virginia, location.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.


