By application filed on April 20, 2010, SoundBite Communications, Inc., Bedford, Massachusetts, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device to a telephone line.

Applicant is a corporation, with its headquarters located in Bedford, Massachusetts, whose mailing address is 22 Crosby Drive, Bedford, Massachusetts. Applicant proposes to connect a NMS automatic dialing-announcing device utilizing SoundBite proprietary software in conjunction with NMS media processors, located in Sommerville, Massachusetts.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-499 be, and it is hereby granted and SoundBite Communications, Inc., Bedford, Massachusetts, be and is hereby, authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official permit as set forth in this order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.
