OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed November 10, 1970, Caroline Hadley, Omaha, Nebraska, charged defendant, Northwestern Bell Telephone Company with discrimination in its deposit requirement.

Defendant filed its Answer to the complaint on November 25, 1970, and public hearing was scheduled to be held on the matter on January 27, 1971, at 9:30 A. M. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska.

On January 14, 1971, complainant filed a motion to withdraw its formal complaint stating that defendant has abandoned its request for an unreasonable and arbitrary deposit for telephone services, and that said actions are satisfactory to complainant.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint, the motion to withdraw and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed as satisfied and the public hearing scheduled for January 27, 1971, should be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska State Railway Commission that Formal Complaint 1047 be and it is hereby dismissed as satisfied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that public hearing now scheduled for January 27, 1971, be and it is hereby cancelled.
