OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed September 24, 1971, Chrisp's Telephone Company, Paxton, Nebraska, charges that Elsie Mutual Telephone Company, Elsie, Nebraska, had invaded its territory by providing telephone service to Donald Thompson located in Section 2, Township 11 North, Range 36 West, Perkins County, Nebraska.

Public hearing was scheduled on the formal complaint but was continued to a date to be later determined at the request of the parties.

On October 4, 1972, complainant advised the Commission that an agreement had been reached between complainant and defendant as to the service area boundary between their several exchanges and requested that its complaint be dismissed.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed at complainant's request as satisfied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska State Railway Commission that Formal Complaint 1056 be and it is hereby dismissed at complainant's request as satisfied.
