OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed October 15, 1971, Answer Omaha, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, charged that the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company was furnishing inadequate service.

Defendant's answer was filed on October 18, 1971, and public hearing on the formal complaint was scheduled to be held February 23, 1972.

On February 15, 1972, a stipulation was filed by the parties requesting that the scheduled hearing be continued and further action be held in abeyance pending possible resolution of the issues, which stipulation was accepted by the Commission.

By letter dated November 12, 1973, complainant requests that its formal complaint be dismissed.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed at complainant's request.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Formal Complaint No. 1058 be and it is hereby dismissed at complainant's request.
