OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed March 15, 1972, the Funk Telephone Company, Funk, Nebraska, charges General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, with invasion of its territory in that General Telephone Company of the Midwest installed and furnished telephone service from its Kearney, Nebraska, exchange to the residence of Loren H. Kring located within the service area of the Funk Telephone Company.

The complaint was served upon the defendant pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. On March 23, 1972, defendant filed a statement of satisfaction wherein it stated that upon investigation of the complaint it found an unauthorized foreign attachment to its facilities (which telephone facilities are located within the Kearney exchange area of defendant); that said foreign attachment has been removed.

On March 25, 1972, complainant filed its acceptance of satisfaction.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint, the statement of satisfaction and acceptance and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed as satisfied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska State Railway Commission that Formal Complaint 1069 be and it is hereby dismissed as satisfied.
