OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed March 1, 1977, the Village Board of Trustees of Cedar Creek, Nebraska, charged that The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, was providing inadequate telephone service.

The complaint alleged that there were too many parties on a line, frequent outages and inadequate service in emergencies.

A copy of the formal complaint was served on the defendant, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company on March 7, 1977, by certified mail. On March 18, 1977, defendant filed a Statement of Satisfaction and a copy thereof was served on complainant.

Said Statement of Satisfaction indicated that defendant would survey the subscribers in Cedar Creek and if a majority thereof so requested would provide four-party service within 60 days of the completion of said survey. In addition, defendant indicated that all one party service would be available to Cedar Creek by February 1, 1980.

On March 31, 1977, complainants submitted a Statement of Acceptance of the satisfaction.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint, the Statements of Satisfaction and Acceptance and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint be dismissed as satisfied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Formal Complaint No. 1106 be and it is hereby dismissed as satisfied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company file with the Commission within thirty (30) days the results of its survey of Cedar Creek subscribers for four party service.
