BY THE COMMISSION:

On this day of June 14, 1977, Complainant came before this Commission and filed a MOTION FOR IMMEDIATE CEASE AND DESIST ORDER PENDING FINAL DISPOSITION of a complaint against General Communications Company, Inc.

Since General Communications Company has no certificate on file with this Commission and since a regulated common carrier appears to be harmed by the Defendant's action, it is the opinion of this Commission pursuant to Commission Rule 8(f) that a temporary and immediate cease and desist order should be granted until such time as oral arguments can be heard on the issue. Oral arguments will be heard on June 24, 1977, at 9:30 a.m., on whether to continue such cease and desist order.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that General Communications Company, Inc. and its agents should temporarily and immediately cease and desist from soliciting or offering the use of a pager system as now allegedly interconnected to the landline system on frequency 152.48 to any member of the public or accepting any new user thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Commission will hear oral arguments on June 24, 1977, at 9:30 a.m., in the Commission Hearing Room, 301 Centennial Mall South, Lincoln, Nebraska, on whether such cease and desist order should be continued.
