BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 14, 1977, this Commission ordered the General Communications Company, Inc., and its agents should temporarily and immediately cease and desist from soliciting or offering the use of a pager system as now allegedly interconnected to a land-line system on frequency 152.48 to any member of the public or accepting any new user thereof.

Pursuant to notice, Oral Argument on the Continuance of the Order to Cease and Desist was heard on June 24, 1977, at 9:30 a.m. The Commission, after Oral Argument and during its regularly scheduled meeting, determined that the original Cease and Desist Order should remain in effect.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that its June 14, 1977, order for General Communications Company, Inc. and its agents to temporarily and immediately cease and desist from soliciting or offering the use of a pager system as now allegedly interconnected to a land-line system on frequency 152.48 to any member of the public or accepting any new user thereof should remain in effect and in force until such time as a final determination is made on this complaint.
