OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 16, 1978, the Commission entered its order sustaining the above captioned complaint and ordered defendant to permanently cease and desist from operating as a radio common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce until such time as it has satisfied and fulfilled the requirements of Section 75-604 R.R.S. 1943 and any other applicable statute or rule.

This order was appealed to the Nebraska Supreme Court, which on July 24, 1979 reversed and remanded the case with directions to dismiss the complaint.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint, and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the complaint should be dismissed in accordance with the mandate of the Supreme Court.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Formal Complaint No. 1107 be and it is hereby dismissed in accordance with mandate of the Supreme Court.
