OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed July 31, 1978, David L. and Diane L. Bolte, Republican City, Nebraska charge that they are unable to obtain telephone service from the General Telephone Company of the Midwest.

A copy of the formal complaint was served upon the General Telephone Company of the Midwest.

By letter dated August 22, 1978, General Telephone Company of the Midwest advised the complainants that the area in which they are located is served by subscriber owned lines; that General is willing to provide service in the area; and that improved rural service would be available in approximately June, 1980.

By letter dated August 28, 1978, complainants indicate their acceptance of the program outlined by the telephone company and ask that their formal complaint be dismissed.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed as satisfied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Formal Complaint No. 1120 be and it is hereby dismissed as satisfied.
