OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed October 9, 1979, Austin Realty Company and Peterson, Bowman & Johanns of Lincoln, Nebraska charged that The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska was charging unauthorized rates.

A copy of the formal complaint was duly served upon the defendant, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company.

On October 29, 1979, the complainants requested that their complaint be withdrawn.
