OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed October 25, 1979, the Hastings College Student Association, Hastings, Nebraska, charged that The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, was discriminating in regard to credit.

A copy of the formal complaint was served upon the defendant, who on November 5, 1979, filed a Statement of Satisfaction of the complaint and an amendment thereto on November 8, 1979.

Defendant's satisfaction indicated that it would permit students with a nine month prompt payment record to qualify as a guarantor, provided said student has telephone service or has an order pending for telephone service.

On November 9, 1979, the complainant accepted the satisfaction of the defendant and asked that its complaint be dismissed as satisfied.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the complaint should be dismissed as satisfied.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that FC-1131 be and it is hereby dismissed ans satisfied.
