OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed April 13, 1983, Don Parr and Jeanette A. Parr, Juniata, Nebraska charged that The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska had refused to provide telephone service requested by complainants.

A copy of the complaint was served upon the defendant and their written answer was received on May 2, 1983. Public hearing on the complaint was scheduled to be held on July 8, 1983.

On July 6, 1983, complainants submitted a motion to withdraw the complaint and the scheduled hearing was cancelled.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed at complainants' request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that FC-1177 be and it is hereby dismissed at complainants' request.
