OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By formal complaint filed August 20, 1987, Richard H. Wells, Stapleton, Nebraska charged that Great Plains Communications, Inc., Blair, Nebraska, had refused to provide mobile telephone service.

On August 31, 1987, complainant filed a Motion to Withdraw his complaint in which he indicates that his complaint has been satisfied.

Upon consideration of the formal complaint and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the formal complaint should be dismissed as satisfied.
