BY THE COMMISSION

On December 15, 1994, the State of Nebraska filed a Formal Complaint against U.S. West Communications, Inc. alleging inadequate service due to the lack of redundancy in the 308 and North 402 LATA's. According to the Commission's Rules and Regulations, unless a Statement of Satisfaction is filed with the complainant, the defendant must provide an answer to the complaint on or before January 11, 1995.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On December 30, 1994, U.S. West filed a motion with the Commission for an extension of time to file its answer to Formal Complaint 1244. Through its motion, the defendant asks permission to provide its answer or Statement of Satisfaction to the above-mentioned complaint on or before February 3, 1995.

The Complainant, the State of Nebraska, Division of Communications, has no objections to the motion for an extension of time.

After consideration of the motion and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. As the Complainant does not object to the delay, the motion for an extension of time may be granted.
2. U.S. West Communications must provide an answer or a Statement of Satisfaction to Formal Complaint 1244, on or before February 3, 1995.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the defendant's motion for an extension of time be, and it is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that U.S. West must provide an answer or a statement of satisfaction to Formal Complaint 1244 on or before February 3, 1995.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that should U.S. West submit a Statement of Satisfaction, the complainant will be given until February 8, 1995 to accept or reject the Statement of Satisfaction. If the complainant rejects the Statement of Satisfaction, US West must provide its answer to the formal complaint no later than February 23, 1995.
