O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On June 17, 2003, Qwest filed proposed revisions to its Qwest Access Services Catalog relating to Common Channel Signaling Access Connection Call Set-up (the "Catalog Amendments"). Such amendments contained a proposed effective date of July 21, 2003.

On July 1, 2003, the Commission, at its weekly meeting, suspended the Catalog Amendments proposed effective date for 30 days in light of concerns expressed by Complainants in the above-captioned proceeding. On July 14, 2003, the Commission received a request from the Complainants that the Commission rescind the suspension of the effectiveness of the Catalog Amendments based on a number of conditions.

In light of the request, the Commission voted on July 15, 2003, to lift said suspension. However, as the issue was not appropriately noticed for action at the July 15 Grist, the Commission desires to reaffirm said decision by the entry of this order.

Accordingly, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the suspension of the Catalog Amendments filed by Qwest on

June 27, 2003, should be lifted and that such amendments shall be considered effective as of July 21, 2003.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the suspension of Qwest's Catalog Amendments filed by Qwest on June 27, 2003, is hereby lifted and that such amendments shall be considered effective as of July 21, 2003.
