BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 27, 2009, OrbitCom, Inc. ("OrbitCom") filed the above-captioned Formal Complaint against AT&T Communications of the Midwest, Inc. ("AT&T") with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"). AT&T filed its Answer and Counterclaim on March 31, 2009. On April 7, 2009, OrbitCom filed a Motion to Dismiss the Counterclaim filed by AT&T.

O P I N I O N

Commission Rules and Regulations contain the requirements for responses allowed by Respondent's to Formal Complaints filed before the Commission. Commission Rules of Procedure regarding responsive pleadings to Formal Complaints state as follows: "An answer to a formal complaint shall be filed and shall admit or deny each material allegation of the formal complaint. The answer shall set forth any affirmative defense which the defense may assert."¹ Clearly, Counterclaims, as was filed by AT&T with its March 31, 2009, Answer are not contemplated by Rule 005.08 or any other of the Commission's Rules of Procedure.

In the event circumstances arise whereby any carrier has grievances with another party under the jurisdiction of the Commission, that carrier is free to petition the Commission to investigate such circumstances or to file a Formal Complaint pursuant to Commission Rules of Procedure.²

Therefore, after examination of all the filings and motions in the current proceeding, we find that OrbitCom's Motion to Dismiss AT&T's Counterclaim should be granted.
