O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 22, 2002, a joint application was filed by Qwest Corporation (Qwest) of Denver, Colorado, and Qwest Wireless LLC (Qwest Wireless) of St. Paul, Minnesota, seeking approval of an amendment to their type 2 wireless interconnection agreement. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on May 23, 2002. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Pursuant to Section 252(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Qwest and Qwest Wireless entered into an interconnection agreement, which was approved by the Commission on March 21, 2000, in Application No. C-2222. In the current application, Qwest and Qwest Wireless seek to amend the original agreement by adding terms and conditions for Single Point of Presence in the LATA and for InterLocal Calling Area.

The amendment does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement. Furthermore, the implementation of the amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

Section 252(e) of the Act requires this Commission to review negotiated interconnection agreements to ensure they comply with Sections 251 and 252(d) of the Act, as well as all applicable state laws. Using those standards, the amendment filed May 22, 2002, should be approved.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the amendment to the interconnection agreement between Qwest Corporation and Qwest Wireless LLC, be, and it is hereby, approved.
